<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pay Federal, State, and Local Taxes ● Serve in Military ● Serve in Federal and Local Juries ● Obey Federal Laws

Wyoming Residents' Rights	DC Residents' Rights
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 2 Senators ● At least 1 Representative ● Vote for President ● Congress cannot interfere with local laws or budget 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 0 Senators ● 0 Representative ● Vote for President ● Congress CAN interfere with local laws and budget

* The District government creates the District of Columbia's budget and writes the District of Columbia's laws. However, at any time and for any reason, Congress may repeal, rewrite, or override the District government's decisions.
