Visual Description of the Video:

DC Vote's educational video "Bring Democracy Home" features a montage of women and men from the District of Columbia who have served in the United States Armed Services from the Civil War to the War in Iraq. The video also features footage of American service members in action along with photos of Washington, DC, and America's national memorials to members of the armed services.

Script of the Video:
